### 1. Playing Venue

The "Rodos Palace Hotel above2 International Open Chess Tourament" will be held in the **5-star Conference Hotel "Rodos Palace"**, on the northern seaside of Rhodes. The venue is 10 km away from the island's international airport (IATA code of the airport: RHO).

### 2. Tournament schedule

### 3. Technical Regulations

- 3.1 The tournament will be a 9-round Swiss, FIDE rated and open to all players with a FIDE ID number.
- 3.2 The time limit for each player is 90 minutes for 40 moves + 15 minutes for the rest of the game + 30 seconds increment for every move played, starting from the 1<sup>st</sup> move.
- 3.3 A player forfeits the game if he/she hasn't appeared at the board within 30 minutes of starting time.
- 3.4 Tie-break criteria: The final ranking of the players is determined by the number of points scored. If, at the end of the tournament, two or more players tie for 1<sup>st</sup> place or for any place in the standings, the tie shall be broken according to the following criteria for Swiss events, in order of priority:
  - i. Results of direct encounters between the tied players (applies only if all tied players have played each other).
  - ii. Buccholz Cut 1.
  - iii. Buccholz.
  - iv. The greater number of games played with black.
  - v. The greater number of wins.
- 3.5 The FIDE Anti-Cheating rules and guidelines are valid for this tournament.

- 3.6 Appeals against decisions of the Chief Arbiter must be submitted in written form to the Chairman of the appeals committee within 20 minutes after the completion of the respective game. The protest must be accompanied with 150 €, as a deposit from the signatory. If the appeal is granted, the sum shall be returned immediately. If the appeal is refused, the deposit is forfeited and added to the prize fund as additional amount for the 1<sup>st</sup> place. The decisions of the Appeals Committee are final.
- 3.7. The Tournament Director is Mr. Nikolaos Vasilakis, Chief Arbiter is Ms. Tania Karali IA.

### 5. Registration cost and deadline

The deadline for registrations and bookings is **19 July 2026**, together with a 30% deposit payment for the selected registration-accommodation package. Kindly note that August is an incredibly busy, high season period for tourism in Greece. Therefore, it is very possible that the event's capacity may be sold out before the deadline of 19 July 2026. Make sure that you register before the deadline!

### 6. Entry Fees

Players **staying outside** the official tournament hotel **will be charged** the registration entry fee as listed above. The deadline for registrations is **19 July 2026**.

### 7. Registration procedure

All players, accompanying persons and delegation members have to register before the deadline of **19 July 2026**, together with a 30% deposit payment of the registration package described in article 6 above. After the deadline, a late registration fee of 120 euros per participant may be required. Final payment should be settled before the start of the event.

The complete registration of each person must include the surname/s, first name/s, FIDE ID number, FIDE rating, dates of arrival/departure and passport number (**for visa only purpose**) of each player and each accompanying person. In case of organized delegations, it must also include clearly the name, telephone and e-mail of the Chief of Delegation who must be an adult.

### 8. Cancellation Policy

Entry fees are fully refundable (minus any transaction expenses) only before 19th July. Players with Rating above 2400 are not required to pay an entry fee. Participants can prepay fees: until **July 19th**. From **July 19th** and onwards, an increase of 10€ in participation fee.

### 9. Visa information

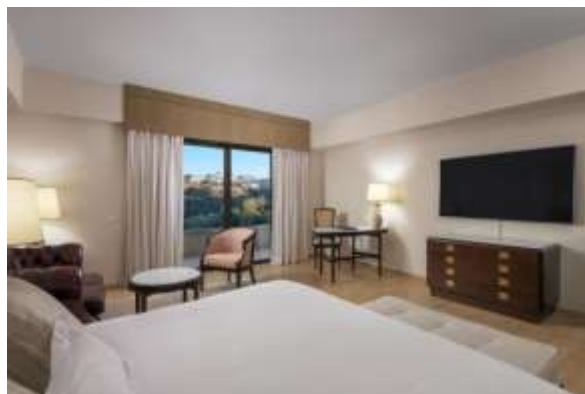
Players and accompanying persons who need a visa to enter Greece, are requested to contact the Organizer earlier, before the **19<sup>th</sup> of July 2026**. The organizer will provide invitations for visas only after the necessary payments are wired for accommodation package, as described in articles 5 and 7 above. Schengen visas are valid in Greece.

Any situation that is not covered by the regulations will be resolved by the Tournament Director and the Chief Arbiter in accordance with the FIDE Laws of Chess.
